10 Presentations

- (1) The presenters must present using a poster or slides. The presentation, poster/slides, and questions and answers must be in English. Explanatory notes and additional materials in Japanese can be used if necessary. Teachers may not help during presentation.
- (2) The presentations need to be about science and/or technology.
- (3) Presentation time is 15 minutes. This includes time for Q and A. There will be 5 minute break between presentations. During this time please fill in the advice sheet and move to the next presenter. Every presenting group should present 3 times, but this may change according to the number of participating groups.
- (4) Each presentation group can use a poster panel which can hold one poster of up to A-0 size. Kobe High School will provide desks, electricity and extension cords for all groups. If you need them, please tell us your requirements in advance on the application form.
- (5) Slides will be projected on a panel of the same size as a poster panel (A0 size). If you require a PC or projector for your presentation, you will need to bring your own.
- (6) Microphones may not be used.
